For BFT, the generosity we have seen from our many supporters has allowed to the BFT Team to accomplish much which will improve the lives of many poor Cambodians, particularly in rural villages

This newsletter provides information on a range of the projects carried out by the Team in 2023 with the generous support of Bob and Indu Shah with Polio Children in Need (UK), Michael Couch (US), Bill Taylor, the SE Asia Foundation (US), our friends at P.O.E.M. (France) and Friends of BFT in Hong Kong, Germany and Australia, Rotary Australia and International, Bikes4Life, and others. Villagers have also benefited from feeding programs and other forms of food supply.

Supporters have helped introduce new initiatives with the potential to provide better futures for many poor Cambodians. Cooperative duck farms (the Gray family), a responsible cow bank and vegetable especially mushroom farms by Tawingo Funds are all introducing new skills to villagers.

The team here at BFT has continued to do great work throughout the year. They have persevered tirelessly throughout the year to better the lives of poor Cambodians. In this, they have been helped by numerous volunteers, including Threads of Red (US) on a return visit, the Singaporean Medical Team Mission and the Australian Volunteer Program. The team has also successfully renewed MoUs with Cambodian Government Ministries which provide the basis for working cooperatively with the Ministry of Interior, Ministry of Education Youth and Sports, Ministry of Health, Cambodian Development Council and others.

Many others have also provided support to BFT and I want to personally thank all of our compassionate supporters, donors and friends from around the world.

Michael Couch's Aid in Kontout and Ta Siem Project in Svay Lue District

Early January 2023, Bill Taylors, the founder of SE Asia Foundation introduced Michael Couch from the USA, Michael landed Siem Reap and was brought to visit BFT projects in Svay Lue and Chi Kreang Districts. Michael started his partnership with BFT and started funding our four years village sustainable project for Prey Lngeang to address the challenges in the 3 areas of Education Development, Health and Nutrition, and Capacity building & Livelihood Improvement. Since the mid of February,



Michael had funded the first five classrooms building for Prey Lngeang, and then another building with multiple use as teacher office, computer laps, library, Khmer traditional dancing class, dining and meeting hall and safe drinking water system and tool shed.



In addition to these Michael also support many hundreds of school uniforms, bicycles, fruit and flower trees, girls feminine pads, school supplies, buying fans, setup playground, football, volley ball and basket ball fields, building toilets, buying teachers and students desks for other nine schools in the same region

English and Computer Program

Our English and Computer programs have continued to operate as normal with larger groups of children at BFT. There are 100 students attending the evening classes from 5pm to 7pm at the evening through Monday—Friday. Around 20 computers learners attending the computer classes different hours from the morning to the evening.







Family Adoption Support

With the funding we received from FoBFT Germany we managed to provide adoption support to help some families in Sre Robong and in Kromom Bol. These families were trained on proper animal and

agricultural techniques and were then provided with some seed money to start their businesses at their own houses. Thanks to the help of FoBFT Germany.

Peace Building



Aim and Ven. Veasna have continued working to provide more consoling support to 30 families from three villages in the districts of Svay Lue and Chi Kreang. The follow up visits have been carried out by the peace building team.

Child Support





Over 20 children at communities and Learning Center have received supports to access public school and learning various skill of English and Computer literacy daily. A big thank you to our donors in Germany for their continued support in providing these children's education, family adoption, and community life skills training. The children and adopted families are so grateful for their compassionate commitment and contributions to making significant changes in their lives.



Mobile Library

Our Mobile Library project has reached 17 schools in the remote rural areas of Siem Reap. We are happy to report that 2025 children and adults participated in our program. They had the opportunity to read, research, and play with the guidance of our librarian and social worker.



In addition, the team also taught hygiene to children and basic health education to all the students from the schools we visited.







The 3rd Rotary Global Grant Project Plan and preparation of washroom in Tapour Village

We would like to let you know that our friends and supporters at Friends of BFT Australia and USA have been working closely with the Rotary Club of Chadstone East Malvern and the Rotary World of Difference foundation on another major project - this time for the installation of community washrooms to provide improved hygiene, reduced water contamination, and also safety and privacy, especially for young women. Siem Reap province.



Currently, our well trained local constructors have been building move than 80 washroom toilets already in Tapour village.



Threds of Red from the USA & UK Hi everyone!

Our group of volunteers from Threds of Red, a wonderful organization from the UK and USA, joined us in conducting health education sessions on menstrual health and hygiene for older girls and boys in school. We also talked to adults and parents about sexual health, sexually-



transmitted diseases and family planning. These are very important topics that are often neglected or misunderstood in these communities. We visited 7 villages and reached out to more than 1000 children of different ages. We also provided health sessions to 516 adults, glasses to 627 people, and support to 12 teachers. We estimate that we interacted with over 1700 people in total, providing education, advice, support and glasses. We were amazed by the enthusiasm and curiosity of the villagers, especially the children, who asked many questions and learned a lot from us.

They showed loving care and sympathy to the villagers, especially the children, who face many challenges and difficulties in their lives. They made a huge difference with their generosity and kindness.



BFT Friends of Hong Kong

The Tawingo Funds and SE Asia Foundation for donations to support projects—Responsible Cow bank in Oroong Village

We are happy to announce that our cowraising workshop in Oroong was a success! eighteen families participated in the two-day training and learned how to care for and breed cows. As a reward, we gave them 20 cows to start their own livestock



business. Each family received two cows and will share the offspring with other families in the community.

We expect that in the next 18 months, there will be at least 15 new calves and more families will benefit from this project. This is a great way to improve their income and living standards.







Financials and Recognition

BFT Expenditure 1 Jan -31 December 2023 (Total US \$ 623,051.69)



BFT Center received donation income of \$630,114 for the year 2023. This represents a very pleasing recovery following the down-turn in income in the two years following the Covid-19 Pandemic, with income up by 188% from 2021.

The major contribution to the increase in funding comes from our very generous donors in the USA and England, while our continued support from Australia, Germany, France, Hong Kong and Singapore is also greatly appreciated. The increased funding has allowed us to further expand delivery of projects and services in our villages. \$170,000 in 2022 to \$470,000 in 2023), while maintaining or increasing investment of facilities and services in all of our other areas.

Importantly, the proportion of expenses relating to administration and fundraising has been kept low, at 3.6% . meaning that 96.4% of the money donated to BFT Center is committed to the delivery of services and projects in the villages.

In the village project, 96.4% of the budget is allocated as follows: 68.84% is dedicated to construction costs, which include the school, library, toilets, hand washing facilities, teacher accommodations, water filtration system, and water storage stands. The remaining 27.56% is used for other operational activities and projects such as training, meetings, travel, project staff, school supplies, feeding, and provision of hygiene supplies.
